During Mr. Brenner's tenure at Prime, he negotiated multiple acquisitions for Prime which grew its revenues from \$27 million in 2004 to more than \$100 million when he left in 2016. Mr. Brenner served on the board of PPAI for five years and was board chair in 2015. In 2020, at the PPAI Expo in Las Vegas, Brenner was awarded PPAI Distinguished Service Award for his work in the industry.


